About Our Club

Clashmore/Kinsalebeg GAA Club has a proud history of Gaelic Games dating back to 1885. The Club has grown and developed over the years to meet the needs of our members and now we are at a stage where we need to expand and develop our facilities to provide a modern state-of-the-art facility to our members and wider community.



Why the need for development?

Increase Capacity: To cater for the ever-increasing number of members & visitors to our grounds

Year-Round Activity: To allow users to play, train & exercise in a safe environment all year round irrespective of the Irish weather

Community Participation: To provide an exercise facility that is accessible to all our patrons, irrespective of age, interest or ability

Modern Facilities: To cater for family orientated events in a modern facility which will help to progress the club and its members

Our Current Facilities

Currently our facilities consist of our main playing field and a juvenile field, a clubhouse with three dressing rooms, a Community Gym (available to all members of the community), a meeting room, a multi-purpose function room (currently home to the local Homework Club) and 32-space roadside parking area.

What are we creating?



Over the next number of years, we plan to transform and expand our club grounds into a 365 sports complex which when completed will allow users to play, train, exercise in quality safe environment all year round irrespective of the Irish weather.

Phase 1

This first phase will consist of three primary components:

- Land Purchase of an adjoining 5 acre plot and levelling of same
- Installation of a 1km floodlit walkway open to all members of the community
- Installation of a new floodlit & sand-based juvenile playing field

Phase 2:

The second phase will consist of these components:

- Installation of an all-weather Astro-Turf pitch
- Installation of a double-sided hurling wall
- Provision of extra car parking spaces
- Upgrade of existing floodlighting system



Timelines:

It is hoped that this fundraising initiative will allow us to complete Phase 1 of this project by the end of 2023 and subsequently to commence work on Phase 2 in 2024.

Project Funding:

We are now seeking to fund Phase 1 of this project and initial projections are that it will cost in the order of €375,000 to complete. This will be a big undertaking for the club but one we feel is essential for the club and the community. The grants available for the purchase and groundwork of facilities are very limited so Phase 1 will need to be self-funded by the club.

The most advantageous way to do this is obtain donations from people and claim back tax from the government. The first step of this process has been to apply for tax exemption status for the purchase and development of Phase 1 which will allow the club to claim an additional tax back if people give a minimum of €250 per annum. In some cases this can be as much as €200 on a contribution of €500. This status has now been granted by the Department of Sport. This tax exemption model is only available if the money is considered a donation and the giver does not receive anything of monetary value in return. Full examples of this below:

Funding Proposal: Sponsor A Plot and secure your place on our "Field of Patrons"

We are asking now families, individuals, to sponsor a plot of 100 sq. m and all sponsor will receive a personalized certificate outlining the field plot which they sponsored and have their name/personalized message placed on our "Field of Patrons". The field of patrons will be a scaled model of the project which will be erected at the entrance to the new field and every sponsor will have a personalized message on their plot (Plot location will be drawn) scaled plot. The "Sponsor a Plot" initiative will be limited to a maximum of 250 patrons.

There are two contribution plans as set out below, one of which is for PAYE workers and the other for businesses/Self-Employed people. You can sponsor a plot by signing up to a monthly payment of €25 a month for a 4 year period or alternatively there is an 'up front' option of paying a total of €1,000 (which can be paid over two installments in the 1st year). As can be seen from the table above. the benefits of this scheme to the club are enormous.

Individual Contributors:

- In order to avail of the benefit of the tax relief scheme, we are asking that sponsors contribute **€25 per month over 4 years** or a **once-off payment of €1,000** (less than €1 per day).

Business Contributors:

- For business and self-employed people who would like to support the sponsor a plot and obtain advertising for their business, we are offering 4-year sideline advertising at the club grounds in addition to the 'Sponsor a Plot' benefits for **€2,000**. The **net cost of this contribution** to a self-employed person at the top rate of tax is **€1,200**.

We fully understand the this is a lot of money to contribute, but all money will be well invested directly into the development project which, when completed, will be of great benefit to every member of the community and will be something that we as a parish can be very proud
